This worksheet will help you organize the necessary information we need to evaluate your site candidates for the first round of funded Expedition: Blue! installations. Expedition: Blue! is an effort of the Cape Cod Chamber of Commerce and the Cape Cod Blue Economy Foundation, Inc. to join with partners across the Cape, Islands and Southern Plymouth County to implement a network of about 20 interpretive sites. These sites will reveal the potential of the water-based economy of the region, provide a platform for exploring its rich cultural, economic and historic assets and be a portal for residents and visitors alike to meaningfully engage in the local blue economy.
